HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1018

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 12-17-12-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 11. The division may approve a grant from the fund to an applicant if the applicant demonstrates to the division that the applicant is able to do the following:

- (1) Provide a physical environment that is safe and appropriate to the various age levels of the children to be served.
- (2) ~~Provide transportation, if necessary, to and from a school or schools to the facility operated by the applicant.~~
- (3) (2) Provide program activities that are appropriate to the various age levels of the children to be served and that meet the developmental needs of each child.
- (4) (3) Provide efficient and effective program administration.
- (5) (4) Provide a staff that meets standards set by the division under section 17 of this chapter.
- (6) (5) Provide for nutritional needs of children enrolled in the program.
- (7) (6) Provide emergency health services to children served by the program.
- (8) (7) Operate a school age child care program in accordance with the cost and expense standards set by the division under section 17 of this chapter.

SECTION 2. IC 12-17-12-17 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 17. The director of the division shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 necessary to carry out this chapter, including rules specifying the following:

- (1) Standards for the hiring of staff for a school age child care program.
- (2) Cost and expense standards for **the following**:
 - (A) Establishing and operating a school age child care program within a school and within a facility other than a school.
 - (B) **Transporting a child to a facility where the child does not attend school.**
- (3) A sliding fee scale for use by school age child care programs that are operating under a grant from the fund.
- (4) Minimum staff to child ratios for a school age child care program.
- (5) Physical space requirements for a school age child care program, including indoor and outdoor space.
- (6) Nutrition requirements for a school age child care program.
- (7) Standards for the provision of emergency health services in a school age child care program.
- (8) Application guidelines and deadlines.
- (9) A method for establishing priority of applicants.
