

## **SENATE BILL No. 19**

DIGEST OF SB 19 (Updated January 11, 2021 9:47 am - DI 140)

Citations Affected: IC 20-26.

**Synopsis:** Required information on student ID cards. Requires a public school that issues a student identification card to a student in grade 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12 to include on the student identification card a local, state, or national: (1) suicide prevention hotline telephone number; and (2) human trafficking hotline telephone number; that provides support 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Provides that the information may be printed on the student identification card or printed on a sticker that is affixed to the student identification card.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

## **SENATE BILL No. 19**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-26-5-40 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2021]: Sec. 40. (a) This section applies to the following:
4	(1) A public school, including a charter school.
5	(2) All students of a school described in subdivision (1) who
6	are in grade 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12.
7	(b) This subsection applies to a student identification card issued
8	to a student after June 30, 2021. If a school issues a student
9	identification card to a student, the school shall include on the
10	student identification card a local, state, or national:
11	(1) suicide prevention hotline telephone number; and
12	(2) human trafficking hotline telephone number;
13	that provides support twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days
14	a week.
15	(c) A school may include the information described in subsection
16	(b) on a student identification card by:
17	(1) printing the information on the student identification card

2	(2) affixing on the student identification card a sticker with
3	the information printed on the sticker
