

HOUSE BILL No. 1352

DIGEST OF HB 1352 (Updated January 24, 2023 9:31 am - DI 140)

Citations Affected: IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Telehealth services. Provides that the office of Medicaid policy and planning may not require: (1) a provider that is licensed, certified, registered, or authorized with the appropriate state agency or board and exclusively offers telehealth services to maintain a physical address or site in Indiana to be eligible for enrollment as a Medicaid provider; or (2) a telehealth provider group with providers that are licensed, certified, registered, or authorized with the appropriate state agency or board to have an in-state service address to be eligible to enroll as a Medicaid vendor or Medicaid provider group.

Effective: July 1, 2023.
